## Kaufman retains Ga'ash title

Steve Midkiff, Avi Farkash and Gidon Drimer all had 145 net in the "A" Division. On the count out, first place net went to Steve and second place to Avi.

Reeve had it much easier winning the Women's Club Championship with an excellent nine over par 79
